Dear HF friends,

this newsletter is a reminder that abstracts for the 11th Nordic HF Conference HF 16 are due on 15 February 2016. The second announcement with the preliminary programme will be published in late March or early April.

HF 16 will cover VLF, LF and HF systems and other long-haul communication systems "over the horizon".

Please spread that the conference will take place on Monday-Wednesday 15-17 August, 2016, with arrival on Sunday.

On Sunday afternoon August 14, HF 16 buses will take you from Visby airport (VBY) and harbour terminal to the traditional venue on Fårö, north of Gotland in the Baltic Sea. For timings, public transport and taxi services, please see our website. The Rohde&Schwarz Bavarian buffet will be served between 1700 and 2200.

On Wednesday afternoon 17, HF 16 buses will catch afternoon flights and evening ferries. You may thus attend meetings in Stockholm on Thursday-Friday 18-19 August.



All meals will be served in the restaurant where manager (Mrs) Anna-Greta Grund will treat us well.

WLAN and LAN fiber network (new) covers the venue. Mobile data/phone access is excellent. The auditorium has all facilities.

The social activities will include a concert in Fårö church, an exhibitors' party, a radio fox hunt and a banquet Gotland style. The new Ingmar Bergman centre is nearby.

The registration fee with full board, lodging and all social activities will be SEK 12,600 + VAT, unchanged since HF 10. Students and retired seniors pay SEK 4,200 + VAT. A limited number of scholarships are available. Family members and weekend stays are welcome at a nominal cost. The lodging standard at the camp varies; early registration is recommended.
