the 11<sup>th</sup> Nordic HF Conference HF 16 will take place Monday-Wednesday 15-17 August with arrival Sunday 14 in time (1700-2200) for the Rohde&Schwarz Bavarian buffet.

We will have 20 presentations and 2 keynotes by Diplom-Ingenieur Harald Wickenhäuser, retired from Rohde & Schwarz, and professor emeritus Eric E. Johnson of New Mexico State University.

The venue is on Fårö, an island north of Gotland in the Baltic sea. From the Swedish mainland, ferries leave from Nynäshamn, Oskarshamn and Västervik for the county capital of Visby, a medieval town and a UNESCO world heritage.

There are several airlines to Visby. Please note that flights from the Swedish mainland to Visby (VBY) are domestic, i.e. you must retrieve your baggage when arriving in Sweden.

HF 16 buses will leave from Visby airport and harbour terminal on Sunday afternoon August 14. On Wednesday 17, HF 16 buses will catch afternoon flights and ferries for meetings in Stockholm Thursday-Friday 18-19.

Avis, Hertz and Europcar have offices at VBY.
